



Leadership Module Quick Reference Guide



Purpose

The TIER Leadership module comprises six pathways, or trainings. These pathways aid leaders in implementing the elements and processes needed to plan instruction, problem solve, and consistently analyze data effectively within a multi-tiered system of supports (MTSS) framework.

Pathway	Objectives
 Creating the Instructional Program	Leaders learn about key elements of the instructional program as it relates to MTSS and reflect on and outline their campus or district instructional programs.
 Creating an Assessment Plan	Leaders learn how to select research-based assessments, provide training and support in assessment administration, create an assessment calendar, manage data, use data at the campus level, and support teachers using data.
 Developing and Using an MTSS Problem-Solving Team	Leaders explore best practices for MTSS problem-solving teams, including defining roles, setting meeting calendars, planning effective meetings, and creating consistent expectations.
 Ongoing Professional Development and Support	Leaders learn about best practices for professional development relating to MTSS, including annual plans, initial training and support, in-class support, and support for teachers' ongoing data use.
 MTSS: Relationship With Other Programs	Leaders examine the relationship between MTSS and other programs, including tutoring, special education, and caregiver collaboration.
 Your MTSS Plan	Leaders learn how to organize their programs and processes in their campus or district MTSS plan.
